### RESIDENTIAL BUILDING PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE

The following Building Permit Fee Schedule is a sample representation of what the actual cost may be. Each project will be evaluated to determine the actual fee. Each municipality may have their own individual administrative fees added to the cost. Each permit includes a State-required fee of \$5.00. ICC

K2 Engineering, Inc follows International Code Council (ICC) guidance when determining the cost of building permits. The ICC focuses on creating safe, affordable, and sustainable buildings. County and city governments throughout the United States model their construction requirements on the ICC's standardized building codes. The ICC not only drafts building codes, but it also certifies our inspectors who review and approve construction projects.

#### RESIDENTIAL NEW CONSTRUCTION — PERMIT FEE IS BASED ON SQUARE FEET

K2 Engineering uses ICC's Building Valuation Data (BVD) table (August 2022) to determine the "average" Square Foot Construction Cost (SFCC). The Total Square Feet (TSF) is multiplied by this cost to obtain the Total Cost of Construction (TCC). The permit fee is calculated by multiplying the TSF by the SFCC to determine the TCC. It is then multiplied by a Permit Fee Multiplier (PFM) of .45% for all residential new construction. The \$5.00 State Fee is then added.

Example: A 1,500 SF single family dwelling is designated as Use Group "R-3" with "VB" construction (pulled from the BVD Table). The permit fee would be determined as follows:

> $1,500 \times \$166.08 = \$249,120.00 \times 0.0045 + \$5.00 = \$1,126.04$ SFCC TCC + State Fee = Building Permit Fee

\*Plans are required at time of submission.

#### RESIDENTIAL RENOVATIONS/ALTERATIONS — PERMIT FEE IS BASED ON NUMBER OF INSPECTIONS

For residential structures that have fire, flood, or other types of damage, the permit fee will be based on the number of inspections required at \$100.00 per inspection. It will be necessary to speak with the inspector for a price to be determined.

IN THIS INSTANCE, A \$100.00 RE-INSPECTION FEE WILL APPLY. ELECTRICAL RE-INSPECTIONS DUE TO A FAILED INSPECTION WILL BE \$125.00.

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#### COMMERCIAL BUILDING PLAN REVIEW—TO BE PAID AT TIME OF SUBMISSION

All Commercial Construction Plans must be reviewed and approved by a Plans Examiner. Two sets of stamped, sealed plans prepared by a licensed architect/engineer are required. A digital copy of the plans is requested & preferred & can be sent to permitting@k2engineering.net.

Plan Review Fee for Signage

Depending on the number of hours used during the Plan Review, the cost can be less. Any amount remaining will be applied to the building permit fee.

#### COMMERCIAL NEW CONSTRUCTION — PERMIT FEE IS BASED ON SQUARE FEET

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All New Commercial Construction & Additions

SF Construction Cost x Total SF x 0.006

Example: A 5,000 SF business is designated as Use Group "B" with "IIB" construction (pulled from the BVD Table). The permit fee would be determined as follows:

> $5,000 \times \$236.05 = \$1,180,250.00 \times 0.006 + \$5.00 = \$7,086.50$ **SFCC** TCC PFM + State Fee = Building Permit Fee

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### COMMERCIAL BUILDING PERMIT FEE SCHEDULE

### COMMERCIAL RENOVATIONS/ALTERATIONS — Permit Fee is based on construction level & square feet

For Commercial Renovations/Alterations, a Construction Level Multiplier is assessed during plans examination and based on the Level of Construction as defined by the 2018 International Existing Building Code (IEBC). The permit fee is calculated by multiplying the Total Square Feet (TSF) by the BVD Square Foot Construction Cost (SFCC) to determine the Total Renovation Cost (TRC). This figure is multiplied by the Construction Level Multiplier (SLM) to provide an Adjusted Renovation Cost (ARC). The ARC is multiplied by a Permit Fee Multiplier (PFM) of .60%. Please see the chart below.

Example: A 1,500 SF church is being renovated where over 50% of the building will be affected. The church designated as Use Group "A-3" with "IIB" construction (pulled from the BVD Table). The permit fee would be determined as follows:

> $1,500 \times \$285.91 = \$428,865.00 \times 0.6 = \$257,319.00 \times 0.006 +$ \$5.00 = \$1.548.91 x CLM =ARC x PFM + State Fee = Building Permit

#### **COMMERCIAL SOLAR PANEL ARRAY**

Commercial Solar Panel permit fees will be calculated at \$0.50 per square foot of panel array. A \$125.00 inspection fee will also be assessed per inspection.
